CHILI COOK-OFF RULES

1. \$15.00 entry fee (proceeds go to prize money and trophies)
2. Chili must be cooked on site. Only beans can be pre-cooked off site.
3. No endangered species meat allowed in chili.
4. Chili will be judged on the chili only. No added condiments (sour cream, cheese, etc.) are allowed until after the judging samples have been collected.
5. You can unload as early as 6:00 am, but you must be unloaded before 9:00 am as no vehicles will be allowed in the cooking area until after 5:00 pm when clean up is to start.
6. A minimum of 4 gallons of chili must be cooked.
7. Cooks must furnish their own cooking utensils, food, tables and stove (Coleman stove, BB-Q grill or gas grill). Booths will be on concrete slab (tennis courts), if you need shade you will need to bring your own tent. We encourage everyone to decorate their booths and themselves. It makes it more fun. If you need tables, we will have some available for a \$10.00 fee. You can request one on entry form.
8. Chili for judging to be picked up ONLY by officials at your table. Judging will be shortly after noon.
9. Wrist-bands will be sold for chili tasting to take place after all entries are collected for the judging, with money collected being donated to the **STUART TOURISM COMMITTEE**. Please remember this is to be a tasting, no chili is to be served to anyone without a wrist-band. Cups, spoons & crackers will be provided.
10. All animals must be leashed, owners will be liable.
11. First place.....1st place Trophy, Cash
Second place.....2nd place Trophy
Third place.....3rd place Trophy

Flea Market and Craft Booth Rules

1. \$15.00 booth fee allows you to set up.
2. You must be unloaded by 9:00 am as no cars will be allowed to enter or leave display area after this time. Vehicles cannot be brought in until after 5:00 pm. There are camping facilities at the park. There are a few campgrounds in and around Stuart and there is a Motel in Stuart, and one in a neighboring town (see below for listing). If you need tables, we can supply tables for a \$10.00 fee. Please reserve your site as soon as possible. Sites will be assigned on first come first served basis.
3. ***All animals must be leashed and cleaned up after, owners liable.***
4. No food concessions allowed. Exceptions, baked goods (cakes, breads, pies etc. Nothing that will compete with selling of chili at the cook off.) or jams & jellies or spices.
5. Please deposit all trash in trash cans and properly. Please dispose of cigarette butts so we don't have to pick them up and also so they don't pose a fire hazard.

Judging Procedures

1. Need a minimum of 4 or 6 judges. Always has to be an even number.
2. Chili Entries will be picked up by officials only. They will go to each table and collect the entries.
3. Entry cups will have name of participant and when picked up that cup will be put into a numbered cup and recorded by the tallying officials.
4. Judging will be rated 1st, 2nd, 3rd. Choice
5. Tally of Judges votes will be done by 2 separate individuals (These two will be the only ones who know the identity of each entry.
6. The judging samples will be assigned numbers and Judges will not know who's they are. The entry with the most amount of 1st place votes takes first place. The most with 2nd place votes takes second, and the entry with the most amount of 3rd place votes takes 3rd.
7. In case of a tie for any place the judges will taste the entries for that place only.
 - ☞ Example: Two entries are tied for 1st, and 3 are tied for 3rd. The judges will re-taste the 3rd place entries and vote for their favorite of the three. When complete the 1st place entries will be judged again.

Presentation of Awards

1. After Judging is complete and all participants have sold samples to everyone, the ceremony will be held at the 7th inning stretch of the old fashioned baseball game @ 2:00 p.m
2. Plaques handed out will be participation plaques.
3. The 3rd Place trophy is awarded.
4. The 2nd Place award is next.
5. Finally the 1st Place Trophy and cash prize is awarded.

Participants will clean up their area after 5:00 PM.
